NEW YORK STATE ANTIQUE TRACTOR PULLERS RULES

1. The Rule Committee will interpret all guidelines, with their rulings being final. Once rules committee representatives per event make final decision. **ALL DRIVERS MUST ATTEND DRIVERS MEETINGS.**
2. Driver must stay on seat at all times. Hands must be on steering wheel, hand clutch, hand breaks, or throttle at all times.
3. Tractors must be naturally aspirated: no turbo or blowers, except Oliver sGM.
4. ****RPM's are checked at fast idle. STOCK CLASSIC ANTIQUE 10% Margin of error. No electric or Stock Plus Electric Fans or over center governors. RPM's cannot be checked, you will be disqualified. NO EXCEPTIONS!! Positive throttle stops required.**
5. The tractor must have the stock engine frame, transmission, rear end axle housing or a manufacturer's replacement. Tractors must have hood and grill in place and have stock appearances intended by manufacturer.
6. Any part falling off tractor after being hooked and until tractor is unhooked will result in disqualification.
7. **DRAWBARS-STOCK CLASSIC ANTIQUE: Maximum height 22 inches, minimum from center of rear axle to point of hook 22 inches (adjustments may be made to meet dimensions.)**
8. Wheelie bars recommended in stock classes.
9. Weights, **STOCK CLASSIC ANTIQUE: Front weights must not extend more than 24 inches from center of the front axel to front most part of weight, with front wheels pointed straight ahead. Weights must not extend beyond the rear tires and cannot extend more than 24 inches to side beyond the rear tires.**
10. **No homemade manifolds INTAKE OR EXHUST WILL BE ALLOWED.**
11. Tractor models manufactured beginning in 11958 may run through their model entirely.
12. Two wheel drive tractors only.

* **Rim width should match tire- This will be enforced.**
13. If on the first pull the sled failed to pass the 50-foot mark, restart will be

- allowed. Restarts from only the shifting of gears will be allowed for restarts. Operator may not leave seat unless to restart tractor.
14. The tractor must remain in bounds at all times during the pull, but the sled may go out of bounds. Out of bounds must be clearly marked.
 15. The tractor pull will be run in a manner that is fair to all those participating and will participate in a fair manner.
 16. **NO OPERATORS UNDER THE AGE OF 14.** Operators between the age of 14-18 must have a written consent from parent or guardian.
 17. Any tractor or puller found to be unsafe or illegal may be disqualified or barred from hooking. **No consumption of ALCHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE PERMITTED.** Any person under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be allowed to pull.
 18. Drivers are **ONLY** permitted to pull in the antique tractor pull **OR** the out of field tractor pull. **NOT BOTH.**
 19. All antique tractors are limited to a speed of 3.5 mph after the 100 ft mark is reached. Speed will be monitored by the sled operator. Any antique tractor moving at a higher rate of speed beyond the 100 ft mark will be disqualified.
